



## USA-EAST Sled Pulling<sup>LLC</sup>

Your 2021 membership form for USA-EAST is enclosed. Please be sure to return this form and the required payment before December 31, 2020 in order to receive the lowest possible membership fee. If you are a current member of USA-EAST, your membership fee for a *renewal* is just \$100.00.

If you were **not** a member of USA-EAST in 2020, your 2021 membership will cost \$175.00.

After December 31<sup>rd</sup> all memberships (including renewals) will be \$175.00. The goal is to maintain this pricing structure in order to keep the cost of your membership as low as possible. With timely renewal year-after-year your membership will stay at just \$100.00.

We plan for USA-EAST to offer a monetary point fund in 2020 for All USA—East Sanctioned Classes—including the *Triple Crown Series*.

You must complete and sign the “WARRANT OF CLUTCH, FLYWHEEL and BELLHOUSING COMPONENTS” form for your truck or tractor unless your truck is still ‘Street Licensed’ and ‘Street Insured’ and competing only in one of the street licensed classes. We will not issue your membership cards without this signed form.

A membership with USA-EAST allows you to participate in all of the pulling events and allows you to collect points and to be a member of the 2021 points race. Point funds as well as other awards and prizes will be offered to most classes that compete with USA-EAST in 2021.

Your membership is for your vehicle (tractor or truck or semi) and for you and for one (1) additional person – helper, wife, crewman, etc. Two membership cards (you and one other person) will be issued with each paid membership. Any member of USA-EAST may drive any vehicle at any event and that vehicle will collect points. The points for the USA-EAST point fund follow the truck or tractor regardless of the driver.

Your membership card will be sent to you via US mail. You may look at our web site at [www.fullpullproductions.com](http://www.fullpullproductions.com) for any up-to-date information regarding your class. Your class rules will also be posted on our website by the end of December.

Remember the December 31 deadline for reduced price memberships. We welcome you as a member of USA-EAST in 2021.

### Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.

- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)

- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
- Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

*If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding, later.*
